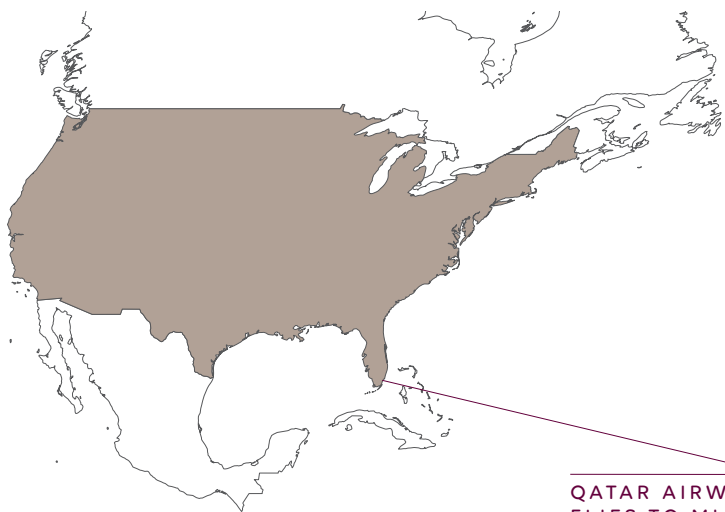

The big picture

Argentinian developer Alan Faena has achieved the impressive feat of transforming some rundown blocks near South Beach into an epicentre of cool. He and his business partner have taken the faded hotels and empty condominiums of the area, and turned them into the Faena District,

which includes the hip Casa Faena hotel, Norman Foster's Faena House – a residential tower with sharp wrap-around terraces – and Rem Koolhaas's beautiful arts centre, the Faena Forum.
